# STATEWIDE MULTIMODAL TRANSPORTATION PLAN UPDATE DRAFT PUBLIC PARTICIPATION PLAN

#### **OVERVIEW**

The Minnesota Department of Transportation is updating the Statewide Multimodal Transportation Plan (SMTP). MnDOT released a revised draft of the Public Participation Plan (known as the Updated Public Participation Plan), which outlines how Minnesotans will be involved in the SMTP update, for formal public review and comment on October 18, 2021. The comment period closed on December 10, 2021. MnDOT advertised the public comment period in the State Register and via the project website and email updates. Minnesotans were able to submit comments via online form, email or via phone.

This document summarizes the comments submitted by Minnesotans throughout the public comment period and provides the MnDOT's response. The final Updated Public Participation Plan is available at https://minnesotago.org/give-us-your-input.
